MAST is seeking U12 Assistant Coaches for the 2022-23 season, September to April.

Responsibilities

Under the direction of the U12 Head Coach, implement a nation leading U12 program by:

- Executing daily on-snow lesson plans as designed by the Head Coach.
- Providing challenging on-snow training environments.
- Ensuring a safe training and race environment for athletes.
- Taking ownership of the athletes' development.
- Assisting in course setting as needed to meet the daily objectives.
- Ensuring all athletes are abiding by the NASA Code of Conduct.
- Leading a group of U12 athletes and developing appropriate technical and tactical skills.
- Weekend availability required. Occasional weekday (daytime) availability may be required.
- Weeknight availability required. Ability to travel for competitions required.

Qualifications and Characteristics

- 3+ years' general ski coaching experience or experience coaching at U14 or higher.
- Minimum ACA DL-Trained.
- DL-Certified and CSIA Level 1 an asset
- Degree in Education and Kinesiology, Physical Literacy or related field an asset.
- Strong understanding and knowledge of the ACA LTD plan.
- Team player, able to work well and communicate with other members of a larger coaching team.
- Comfortable communicating effectively with parents, athletes and coaches with high level of diplomacy.
- Skill development oriented, highly motivated and holds self and others to a high standard.
- High level of energy, stamina, professionalism, and dedication.
- Personal high level ski racing experience an asset.
