- Ensuring a safe training and race environment for all athletes while delivering the content in a fun and creative way.
- Taking ownership of the athletes’ development.
- Keeping up to date training journals, attendance records and completing report cards for all athletes.
- Course setting as needed to meet the daily objectives.
- Ensuring all athletes are abiding by the NASA Code of Conduct.
- Leading a team of U14 Assistant Coaches and providing technical direction to the U14 staff.
- Understanding the full NASA program and its structure. Actively promote the Club to internal and external parties.
