



Volunteer Policy 2023/24 Season

Nakiska Alpine depends on volunteers to make our organization great. Volunteering promotes team building and friendship among the parents. Given that we all need to work together to sow the seeds of our success, it is expected that all parents will donate their time equally to support the program(s) their children are registered in. Please note that races hosted by your child's club require the participation of at least one parent from each family.

The Minimeister program has no volunteer bond, but it is a parented program and parents are required to assist this program by riding the ski lift with their athlete.

Nakiska Alpine introduced the Volunteer Points Policy in the 2016/2017 season. This policy represents the minimum volunteer requirement, and we encourage parents to volunteer for all roles, regardless of whether it checks a box for your volunteer bond or not (i.e. all parents are welcome to be Lodge Parents and/or work extra casino shifts). We will not provide prorated bond deposits for those unable to complete their full, minimum commitment. Parents must complete the following to ensure their volunteer bond does not get deposited:
