Reporting to the U12 Head Coach (HC), the U12 Coach plays a key role in developing our young talent and providing our U12 team with athletes possessing solid technical base, tactical knowledge, work ethic, passion, and desire to succeed.

Responsibilities

- Provide a safe and challenging on-snow training environment appropriate for athletic development.
- Deliver dryland training program as outlined by the HC and Strength and Conditioning coach.
- Take ownership of the athletes’ development.
- Keeping up to date training journals, attendance records, and completing report cards for all athletes.
- Ensure all athletes abide by the NASA Code of Conduct.
- Ensure all MAST issued equipment is maintained and operational throughout the season.
- Understand the full NASA program and its structure. Actively promote the Club to internal and external parties.

Qualifications

- 3+ years’ general ski coaching experience.
- Minimum ACA Entry Level Certified, Development Level Trained/Certified an asset.
- Personal high-level competition experiences an asset.
- Valid Alberta class 4 driver’s license or willingness to obtain.
- Experience working effectively with parents, athletes, coaches, and other stakeholders.
- Strong understanding and knowledge of the Alpine Canada Long Term Athlete Development (ACA LTAD) plan, and the skills pathway.
- Team player able to work well and communicate with other members of a larger coaching team.
- Evening availability Tues and Thurs required. Occasional overnight travel for competitions required.
